Common Name	Botanical name	Spacing Minimum	Annual Growth	Hedge (HxW)	Characteristics
Canadian Hemlock	Tsuga canadensis	6'	8"-18"	6'-35' x 6'	Shade tolerant. Needs protection from wind and drought. Shears well for a formal hedge.
Weeping Alaskan Cedar	Chamaecyparis nootkatensis 'Pendula'	10'	1-3'	25'-35' x 15'	Very distinct look. Evergreen. Deer resistant. Zone 5
Blue, Norway, and White Spruces	Picea spp.	12'	1-3'	15'-40' x 15'	Evergreen. Deer resistant and salt tolerant. Zone 3
Pyramidal Euopean Hornbeam	Carpinus betulus 'Fastigiata'	10'	1-2'	15'-35' x 6'	Shears well for formal hedge. Deer Resistant. Zone 4.

Emerald Green Pyramidal Arborvitae	Thuja occidentalis 'Smaragd'	4'	1-2'	10'-25' x 6-8'	Fast growing. Do not plant if deer are a problem. May need protection from winter wind. Zone 4
Green Giant Pyramidal Arborbitae	Thuja x plicata 'Green Giant'	6'	2-4'	10'-25' x 8-12'	Very fast growing. Partially deer resistant. May need protection from winter wind. Zone 5.
Columnar Beech	Fagus sylvatica Dawyckii varieties, Red Oblisk	8'	1'	10'-35' x 6'	Shears well for formal hedge. Slow growing. Red or gold color. Zone 4.
Rocky Mountain Upright Juniper	Juniperous scopulorum 'Moonglow' 'Wichita' and others	4'-5'	1'	8-12' x 4'-5'	Evergreen. Salt and wind tolerant. Deer resistant. Zone 3.
Fat Albert Blue Spruce	Picea pungens 'Fat Albert'	6-8'	6"-1'	8-12' x 8'	Evergreen. Salt and wind tolerant. Deer resistant. Smaller than regular Blue Spruce. Zone 3.
Pyramidal Cap Yew	Taxus capitata	4-5'	6-12"	8-20' x 8'	Evergreen. Do not plant if deer are a problem. Shade tolerant. Zone 4.
Dwarf Burning Bush	Euonymus alatus 'Compacta'	4'	12-18"	6-10' x 5-10'	Fast growing. Bright red fall color. Shear or allow natural form. Zone 4.
Hatfield Yew	Taxus media 'Hatfield'	3-4'	6-10"	6-12' x 3-4'	Evergreen. Do not plant if deer are a problem. Shade tolerant. Zone 4.
Doublefile Viburnum	Viburnum p. t. 'Shasta' 'Mariesii' and others	5-6'	8-10"	5-8' x 6-8'	White flowers in spring. Red fall color and berries. Zone 5.
Seagreen Juniper	Juniperus chinensis 'Sea Green'	4'	6-10"	4'-6' x 4'-6'	Evergreen. Salt and wind tolerant. Deer resistant. Zone 3.
Privet	spp.	3-4'	1-2'	4-12' x 4'-6'	Very fast growing. Shears well. Tolerate some shade. Can be invasive. Zone 4.
Densiformis Yew	Taxus media 'Densiformis'	3'	6-12"	3'-4' x 3'-5'	Evergreen. Do not plant if deer are a problem. Shade tolerant. Zone 4.
Green Mountain Boxwood	Buxus x sempervirens 'Green Mountain'	24-36"	3-4"	3-5' x 2-3'	Evergreen. Slow growing. Deer resistant. Zone 4.
Chicagoland Green Boxwood	Buxus x sempervirens 'Glenco'	18"	2-3"	12-24" x 12- 24"	Evergreen. Slow growing. Deer resistant. Zone 4.
